What will a day look like?

Will I have to log into all my classes at a certain time every day?

No, as a fully virtual learner, you can choose the time of day when you do your work. You do have to login daily and connect with your teacher regularly (2X/Week Minimum). As long as you are keeping up, we will not require anything else.

Classes from 3rd Trimester Last Year

What do I do if I didn't finish my class from 3rd trimester last year and I still want to earn the credit?

1. Contact Coach Langs, he will direct you to the appropriate teacher.
2. You will have until October 1st to complete.
3. You must demonstrate progress to completion.

Learning Lab

For students without internet access, you may sign up for Learning Lab time at the High School. Approximately 40 spots will be available each day for our students. Based on lab availability, students may be limited to 2 times per week. This lab will be monitored by a parapro. Unfortunately, teachers will not be available.
