Chromebook Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Can I purchase my own insurance?

No, you must annually purchase the Worth Insurance on [RevTrak](#).

Is there any paperwork to be signed?

Yes, there are [two forms](#) to be signed. You must submit signed, **paper copies** the first year you receive a Chromebook.

Why do we need insurance?

Repairing or replacing Chromebooks can cost up to \$200 each occurrence.

Will I be able to keep my Chromebook over the summer?

No, the Chromebook will be returned on the last day of school each year for analysis.

Is the school making money off of my insurance payment?

No, the school does not make money off insurance.

What about sports/after school activities?

Students should keep their Chromebook locked up in their school locker--not their gym locker--and pick up their Chromebook after the event is finished.

I already own a Chromebook; do I need take the school's Chromebook?

No, you do not need to use the school's Chromebook.
