Safety is our main concern and parking permits are issued under the following conditions listed below. Failure to abide by these rules will result in the loss of the permit. Driving/parking violations may lead to additional disciplinary action at any time these occur on school property. Students must understand that driving to school and parking in the student parking lot is a privilege, not a right.

1. **Any and all** vehicles driven to and parked on school property **must** be registered in the PHS main office. A registration sticker will be issued upon receipt of a completed and signed application and a **\$5.00 sticker fee**. The sticker must be visible in the vehicle at all times (such as lower right corner of the windshield).
2. Neither the driver nor any other persons are allowed to be in the car during school hours.
3. Students are to park in student-designated areas only. If parked elsewhere, a ticket will be issued. Tickets will also be issued to any vehicle not possessing a parking sticker.
4. Vehicles must be under control and driven safely on school property at all times.
5. Careless driving, littering, and parking on school property, where prohibited, as reported to and by any school employee whether during or after regular class hours or on weekends, will result in automatic loss of this permit and/or further disciplinary action.
6. **Student Code of Conduct Violations:**
 - a. Students may lose parking privileges as a result of a Code of Conduct violation. All Code of Conduct rules in the high school handbook extend to any student property while on school grounds. For example, tobacco found in a car is a violation of the Code of Conduct rules.
 - b. Any vehicle is subject to search and seizure while on school property. If school officials have "*reasonable suspicion*" that you may possess something illegal or dangerous in your vehicle, by law, we reserve the right to search the car.
1. High School Administration reserves the right to have any vehicle towed that is not in compliance with these rules.
