### LET'S GET PREPARED

We are getting ready and so should you. Please make special time to prepare for the school year with your at-home learner. Just like the students attending school in-person this year, at-home learners need to get excited and ready to put their thinking caps on. You can help by working together to prepare a special learning environment, assemble supplies, and develop a school-ready routine.

### SUPPLIES

- Every learner will need a computer with a camera and audio and access to high-speed internet or WIFI. For a district issued Chromebook, follow instructions from your “home-elementary” to do a Chromebook pickup or follow the link to RevTrak to pay for borrowers insurance and then email [tammy.glupker@plainwellschools.org](mailto:tammy.glupker@plainwellschools.org) to arrange for pickup. Students may use their own device if that is preferred.
- Some items students will need: pencils, markers, crayons, plain colored paper and white lined paper, a few binders or pocket folders, a backpack, crate or box designated for their school items storage and a designated space to engage in learning. These items do not need to be brand new and the student can start with just a few and replenish over the course of the year but they should be designated to each the learner (if there are more than one learner in the home, we suggest labeling) and readily available on day one (September 8).
- Every learner will also need: **a designated home learning partner.** Families should make it clear to the students who it is they will ask first if they have a need while trying to learn at home. Conversations like, “if you’re in the middle of a lesson and none of the markers work, mommy is going to be there to help” or “Grammy is the one to ask if you can’t find your pocket folder with your spelling words” empower your learner to problem solve efficiently.
